

### Sacrament of Holy Baptism

Leader: The Sacrament of Holy Baptism bears witness to the Divine Love and Grace that is extended to each of us at every stage of our lives.

People: Today we celebrate God's love for Dorothy, and offer ourselves as instruments of that love in her life.

L: When parents brought their children to Jesus so that he might touch them, his disciples rebuked them; but when Jesus saw this, he was indignant and said to them,

P: "Let the children come to me and do not hinder them; for to such belongs the Realm of God.

L: Truly I say to you, whoever does not receive the Realm of God like a little child, shall not enter it."

P: Then Jesus took the children into his arms and blessed them, laying his hands upon them.

L: The Sacrament of Holy Baptism is an outward and visible sign of Divine Grace. Because the promise of the Gospel is not only to us, but also to our children, baptism with water and the Holy Spirit is the mark of their acceptance into the care of Christ's Church, the sign and seal of their participation in God's forgiveness, and the beginning of their growth into full Christian faith.

P: Out of the Water of Holy Baptism, we rise with new life, forgiveness and grace as members of the One Body of Christ.

### The Readings

#### The Old Testament - Psalm 138

I give you thanks, O Holy One, with my whole heart; I sing your praise! I bow down toward your holy temple and give thanks to your name for your steadfast love and faithfulness; for you have exalted your name and your word above everything. On the day I called, you answered me, you increased my strength of soul.

All the rulers of the earth shall praise you, O Holy One, for they have heard the words of your mouth. They shall sing of your ways, for great is your glory. For though you are high and exalted, you lovingly regard the lowly; but the haughty and proud, you perceives from far away.

Though I walk in the midst of trouble, you preserve me against the wrath of my enemies; you stretch out your hand, and your right hand delivers me. The Holy One's purpose is fulfilled in me; your steadfast love, O God, endures forever. Do not forsake the work of your hands.

### The New Testament - Mark 3:20-35

The crowd gathered around Jesus again, so that he and his disciples could not even eat. When his family heard it, they went out to restrain him, for people were saying, "He has gone out of his mind." And the scribes who came down from Jerusalem said, "He has Beelzebul, and by the ruler of the demons he casts out demons." So Jesus confronted

them, and spoke to them in parables, "How can Satan cast out Satan? A kingdom divided against itself cannot stand. And a house divided against itself cannot stand. If Satan has risen up against himself and is divided, he cannot stand, but his end has come.... Truly I tell you, people will be forgiven their sins and whatever blasphemies they utter; but whoever blasphemes against the Holy Spirit can never find forgiveness, but is guilty of an enduring sin" [for they had said, "He has an unclean spirit!"]

Then Jesus' mother and brothers came; and standing outside, they sent to him and called him. The crowd around him said, "Your mother and your brothers and sisters are outside, asking for you." Jesus replied, "Who are my mother, my brothers, and my sisters?" And looking at those around him, he said, "Here are my mother and my brothers! Whoever does the will of the Holy One is my brother and sister and mother."

### The Continuing Testament - by James Boyce - in Working Preacher [edited]

Jesus puts it very directly. It is not one's status, but his or her action in response to the Divine Call, that marks what it means to belong to his "family." Even those who have all the proper credentials - whose blood lines would seem to link them to Jesus, or who claim status as leaders of the Temple in Jerusalem - are ultimately at risk for missing out on this journey. That seems to sum it up simply and to the point. Relationships in this family are dynamic; they flow from the encounter - and response - to Jesus.

And yet, at this point in the journey, there remains a hiddenness or a mystery to it all. Relationships in this family are couched in terms of "Doing the Divine Will." But precisely what that "Will" entails is not specifically detailed. For those of us who thrive on lists, who need things to do to establish some comfort level, the call of Jesus will not comply with our wishes. We will have to be willing to come along for the journey. We will just have to trust Jesus and the invitation to join him, and to believe that in his presence we will participate in the unfolding of the Good News of the Divine Realm among us, and within our world.
