

## The Readings

## The Old Testament - Psalm 98:1; 4-9

O sing to the Holy One a new song, for God has done marvelous things. God's right hand and holy arm have obtained the victory.... Make a joyful noise to the Holy One, all the earth; break forth into joyous song and sing praises. Sing praises to the Holy One with the harp, with the lyre and the sound of melody. With trumpets and the sound of the horn make a joyful noise before the Sovereign Holy One. Let the sea roar, and all that fills it; the world and all those who live in it. Let the waters clap their hands; let the hills sing together for joy at the presence of the Holy One, who is coming to judge the earth. The Holy One will judge the world with righteousness, and the peoples with equity.

### The New Testament - Revelation 4:1-3; 8-11

After this I looked, and there in heaven a door stood open! And the first voice, which I had heard speaking to me like a trumpet, said, "Come up here, and I will show you what must take place after this." At once I was in the spirit, and there in heaven stood a throne, with One seated on the throne! And the One seated there looks like jasper and carnelian, and around the throne is a rainbow that looks like an emerald....

Day and night without ceasing, those surrounding the throne sing, "Holy, holy, holy, Divine Bearer of Majesty, who was and is and is to come!" And whenever the living creatures give glory and honor and thanks to the One who is seated on the throne, who lives forever and ever, the twenty-four elders fall before the One who is seated on the throne and worship the One who lives forever and ever; they cast their crowns before the throne, singing, "You are worthy, Sovereign Holy One, to receive glory and honor and power, for you created all things, and by your will they exist and were created."

# **The Continuing Testament** - by Tony Robinson - in *Stillspeaking Daily Devotional* [edited]

Perhaps you've seen the videos of flash mobs breaking into song and dance in stores or food courts. I love these videos! In fact, they can bring me to tears. I wonder why they are so powerful? Partly it is the way the flash mob and its song intrude upon the normal and so often graceless daily grind.

People who look bored and distracted as they munch burgers in the food court. Shoppers mechanically picking through stuff at Macy's. The flash mobs break in, reminding us of another dimension that is all around us, but one to which we so often seem blind.

I also like the courage and the company. One person, then two or three, start in singing or dancing. What courage! Gradually the entire chorus assembles, a community of joy being born before our very eyes, people so caught up in something greater than themselves. And I like the way these videos show us what "witness" looks like. The singers and players witness to another reality, another possibility, a truth and beauty that cannot be suppressed. They put it before us, before the world, and let people make of it what they will.

Could you and I witness like that? With joy and hope, sharing faith and its song, in the midst of a world dying for magic, hungry for mystery and thirsting for God? I think the Church could learn a lot from these flash mobs. Maybe we could become a flash mob ourselves!
