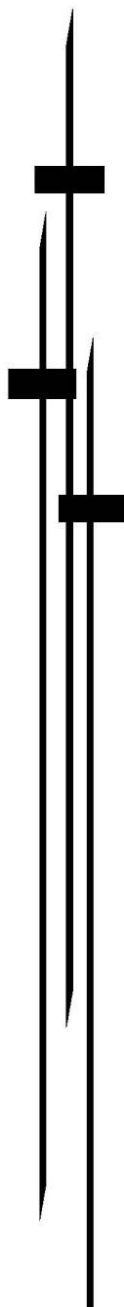

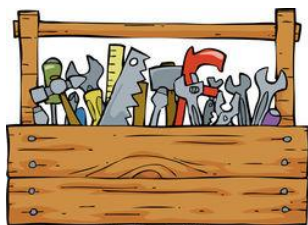


FROM THE MINISTRIES OF BUCC

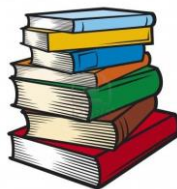
We ask that you read it, follow directions on how to answer it, and turn it into the office no later than Sunday, February 12th. ►
