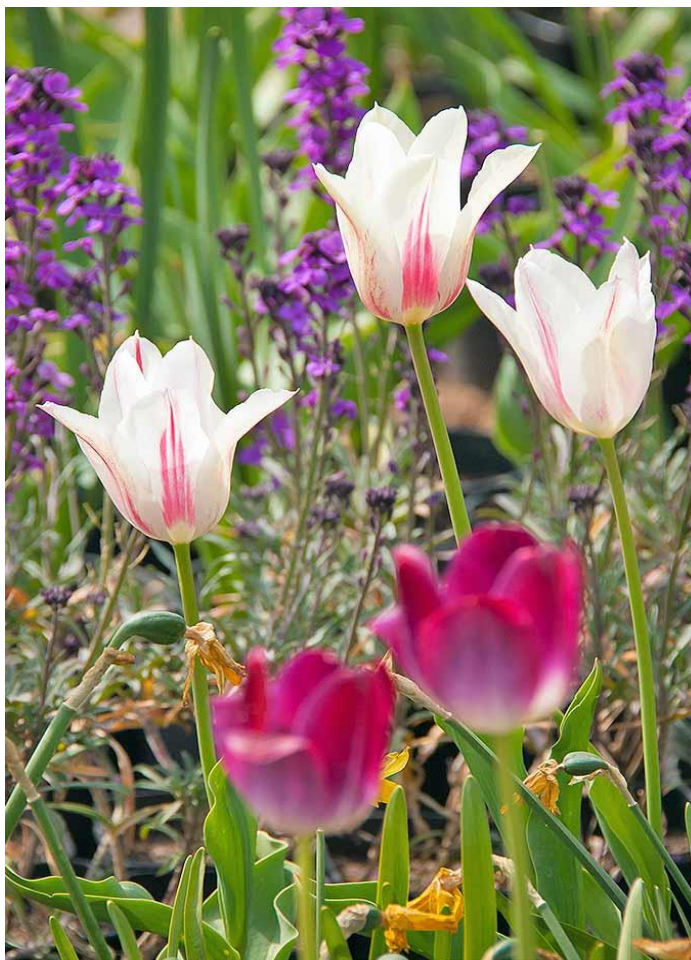

## ***Pastor's Ponderings.....***

### ***The Whole World is Involved***

*“<sup>7</sup>Amazed and astonished, they asked, “Are not all these who are speaking Galileans? <sup>8</sup>And how is it that we hear, each of us, in our own native language? <sup>9</sup>Parthians, Medes, Elamites, and residents of Mesopotamia, Judea and Cappadocia, Pontus and Asia, <sup>10</sup>Phrygia and Pamphylia, Egypt and the parts of Libya belonging to Cyrene, and visitors from Rome, both Jews and proselytes, <sup>11</sup>Cretans and Arabs—in our own languages we hear them speaking about God’s deeds of power.” – Acts 2: 7-11*

As the world is in the grip of a pandemic, geography is much on our minds. Is it flaring again in Wuhan? How is Canada doing? Has Seattle seen the worst of it yet? What’s going on in Mexico and South Africa? This terrible virus is a reminder that we are all in this together, one humanity facing a deadly threat, all around the world. People from East and West, North and South are all affected across the globe.

If we lived in the ancient world, we’d recognize the names of the regions where these astonished language-hearers came from in the list in Acts on the day of Pentecost. Parthians, Medes and Elamites, residents of Mesopotamia were all east of Jerusalem over by where Iraq is today. Cappadocia, Pontus, Asia, Phrygia and Pamphylia were Roman provinces to the north of Jerusalem, covering modern Syria and Turkey. Egypt and Libya were to the southwest of Jerusalem, and Arabia to the southeast. Crete and Rome were to the west of Jerusalem.

So what our text is telling us is that people who heard the good news about Jesus from the disciples on that first Pentecost were from every corner of the world and every direction of the compass. God intended this good news for everyone.

This was an astonishing thing, and the early church didn’t get it at first. It took them quite some time before they realized that God intended the

story of Jesus to be for the whole world. They started off by considering Jesus as a Jewish Messiah for Jews who would believe in him. But the Holy Spirit was working from the very beginning to disabuse them of this parochial notion that the good news of God's triumph over death wasn't for everyone.

Moreover, this is NOT a miracle of the disciples speaking in tongues, that is, in foreign languages. It's not a miracle of speaking, but a miracle of hearing! Everyone *hears* the disciples in their own language. This is to be the model for how we are to share the good news: in such a way that everyone can hear it in a way that they can understand. It's different for everyone, but it's definitely for everyone, too, from North and South and East and West, one message of hope for the whole world.

Here are some further instructions for our current approach to online/dial-in worship, using the ZOOM conference service. There are two ways to join:

##### **1. PHONE:**

If you want to call in:

##### **Dial-in Worship Service:**

then enter meeting ID (followed by the # sign):

During the call, you can unmute yourself by pressing \*6, to say something that all will hear. Then press \*6 to mute yourself again. Hang up at the end of the service.

##### **2. COMPUTER / SMARTPHONE / IPAD:**

If you have not used Zoom before, you JUNE have to download the app the first time you click on the link with your computer.

If you have a smart phone or iPad, you can go to the app store and search for Zoom Cloud Meetings:



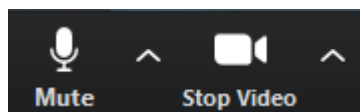
When you click or the link from the email or start the Zoom app on your phone, you JUNE not automatically go into our meeting. If so, press the Join a Meeting button, then you get a screen that asks you for the Meeting ID. Enter: 478 070 5901.

In general, you should use your computer/smartphone/iPad's audio. If you have turned on your video camera, it gives you a chance to see what others will see when you join the meeting.

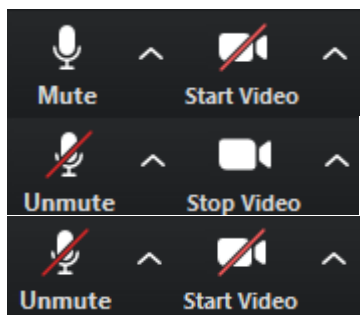
In general, to ensure the best listening experience for everyone, you should be "on mute" most of the time, unless you have something specific to say to everyone.

During the service, you should see these controls:

- on the lower left of your computer screen
- on the lower left of your smart phone
- on the upper right of your iPad



People can see and hear you



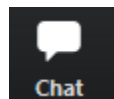
People cannot see you, but they can hear you

The controls show what will happen when you click on them. You toggle between “on” and “off” settings. On your smartphone & iPad, these controls also alternate between red and green.

The collection for Edna House totaled \$500 and will be sent to them shortly.

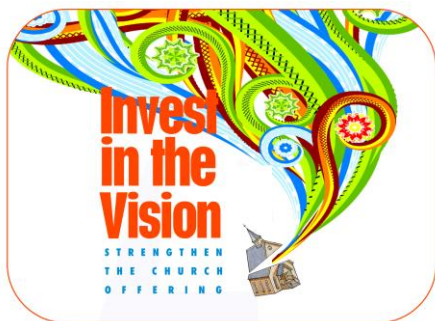
## LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT
