Pastor's Ponderings.....

Equinoxes and solstices are sacred moments. It's good to be mindful of the sermons Earth teaches this season. Last Saturday's equinox preached of balance, gratitude and the coming darkness.

For thousands of years, across different religions and cultures, the autumn equinox was celebrated with fires and chants, songs and dancing. The equinox marks the moment of balance between light and dark; yin and yang.

We did so much with those long summer days. Now, in the northern hemisphere, darkness dominates.

The liturgy of autumn leads me to a reflection, on a balance of light and dark, gratitude and death. Autumn is both beautiful and fearsome.

You are the season of retirement, of full barns and harvested fields.

and the busy work of giving life is now completed.

The harvest leads me to melancholic gratitude. Rejoice. Give thanks. The soil - tilled last spring while still cold - has yielded its crops. The seeds - planted long ago - have borne their fruit. Now we turn with thanksgiving for the abundant blessings of a bountiful God, a glorious Sun and a life-giving Mother Earth. We have worked hard for so long, let's reflect on what it has meant. Breathe deeply now. Give thanks. You are blessed. Hear that again. You are blessed. Blessed with life and family and friends and freedom and so much more.

But autumn leads me to a reflection on death too. Darkness increases, and with it, the unseen. The "Day of the Dead," deeply rooted in centuries of indigenous folklore melded with Christian traditions, leads to festive graveyard scenes. The circle-dancing leaves call to us. We too, shall fall. We too shall join them some day.

Yet Old Woman Autumn carries the secret of life and blessing in her withered hand. The acorns are falling and the squirrels frantically try to bury them all. Even if they could, there is more than they could ever eat. So, the acorns smile as they release their grip, fall to the ground, and are buried.

Spring is coming. They know. They know.

Perhaps the two faces of autumn – thanksgiving and death – are both leading me to the same place. I reflect on the blessing of each moment, each relationship, each sunset, and each ability. It is a treasure, simply to be in relationship with those we love. Fall reminds me; these are not unlimited treasures to be squandered. Indeed, they are the most wonderful things I have. So, dance now, laugh now, serve now, love now.

Katie and I light the fire in the back yard. It's getting colder; it's getting darker. Soon we'll go inside. But for now, we savor these evenings of warmth and light. Autumn is a thick book of wisdom that teaches us to value each moment of this blessed time, this blessed life.

Old Woman Autumn smiles. She calls us to give thanks. She warns us – ponder your demise, you mortals. Then she winks and points to the acorn – you carry within you the seeds of Resurrection.

ADVENT - Our annual Advent Devotional is always highly anticipated. This is a booklet containing daily scripture passages and corresponding reflections, written by members of BUCC. In 300 words or less, write on pretty much whatever you wish - here are some suggestions:

- Reflection on what the scripture you chose means to you - don't worry about using the passage in its entirety. You may want to select a single thought from it and go from there.
- A Christmas memory that may hold special significance to you
- Something going on in the world and what scripture seems to say in response
- Something you may have heard or read related to the scripture passage that has special meaning for you
- Description of a special family (or church) tradition
- The whole meditation may be written as a prayer.
- Sometimes a poem or the lyrics to a special carol works well.

Conclude your passage with a one or two sentence prayer.

Simply select one of the pre-printed verses/dates that will be available during Fellowship Hour and write a short reflection. To give Anne plenty of time to produce the booklet, submissions need to be in her hands by October 31st. Please email your piece to the church office at buccoffice23@gmail.com. 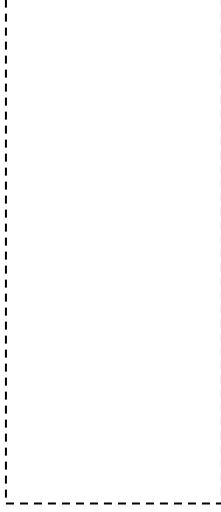
