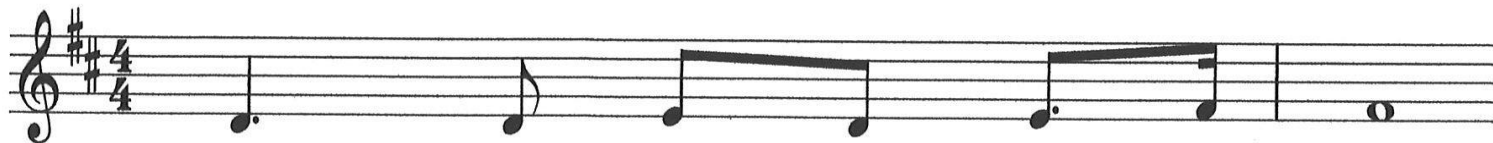

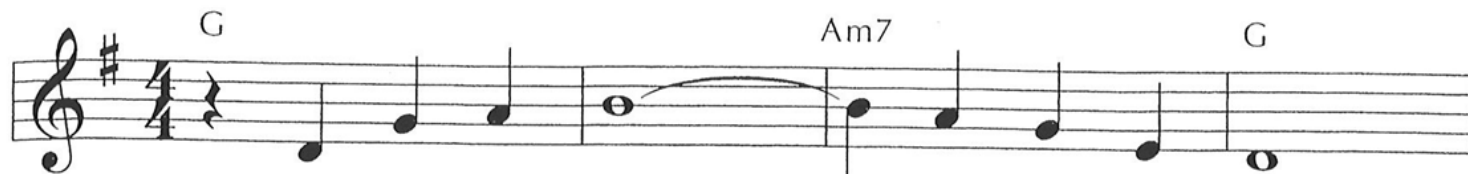

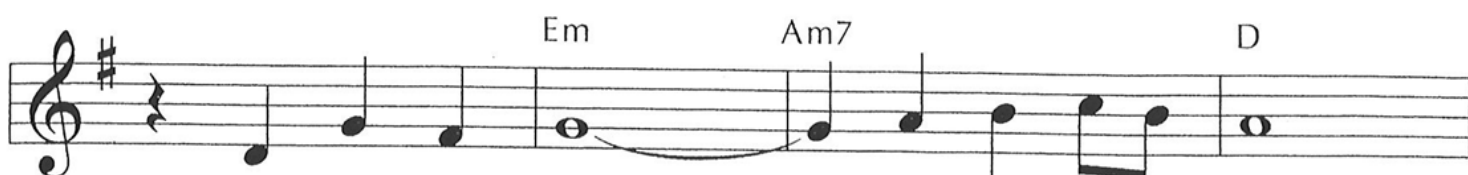
HYMN OF REFLECTION
