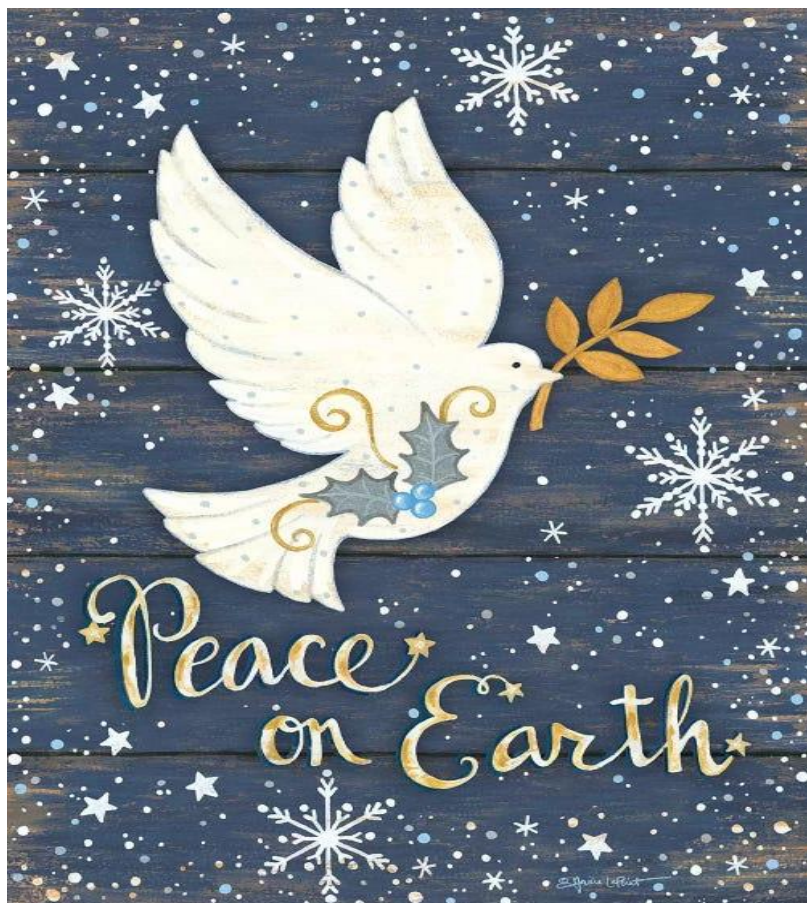

Pastor's Ponderings.....

♪ "It's beginning to look a lot like Christmas!" ♪ For families all around our community this season is filled with many activities. Sometimes it can seem exhausting. I hope that you will find a sanctuary in your church community, a place of peace to replenish your spirit. Church at Christmastime is not just one more activity to add to the list. It is rather, a sanctuary. Let it be our spiritual grounding that restores peace and purpose to the other busy-ness.

Here are some of the ways I hope your church community can be a place of spiritual restoration:

The Christmas Cantata is an annual tradition at Brecksville UCC. Our Choir has been working on it for months already. If the fire of your Christmas spirit has grown dim, then come and get stoked on December 15.



The Season of Advent. It gets confusing, because all around us, advertisers promote the idea that the Christmas season goes from Thanksgiving until Christmas day. But Christmas was the church's idea in the first place; and for us, the Christmas season begins on Christmas Eve and ends ♪"on the twelfth day of Christmas," January 6. The four Sundays before Christmas are Advent, a time of spiritual nourishment. Allow yourself space for extra prayer.

Advent Devotional: Every day of the Advent and Christmas seasons, read the Advent reflections, written by your sisters and brothers, members of Brecksville UCC. Let it be a gift to yourself. Keep a space clear in your hectic schedule to pray and meditate during Advent.

The Children's Christmas Play happens on the following Sunday, December 22 during the Sunday Service. Please, bring the whole extended family to participate in a tradition that goes back generations.



Christmas Eve service begins at 10:00 p.m. As always, it will be a candlelight service. This year, we will have the option of holding an LED candle, instead of a lighted candle. That way everybody can safely participate. Obviously, this is one of the most sacred of all our gatherings. Christmas celebrates the birth of Jesus, the light of the world. It is full of nostalgia for Christmases past, and hope for

Christmases future. But all we really have is Christmas present. Make a plan and invite your family to gather at church on Christmas Eve, so that they can create some memories of their own.

Let your extended family know how much it would mean to you if they could join you again back in your church home. We are family here. George Snider, a long time member of BUCC passed away on November 24. Please keep his wife, Carole, and their family in your prayers.

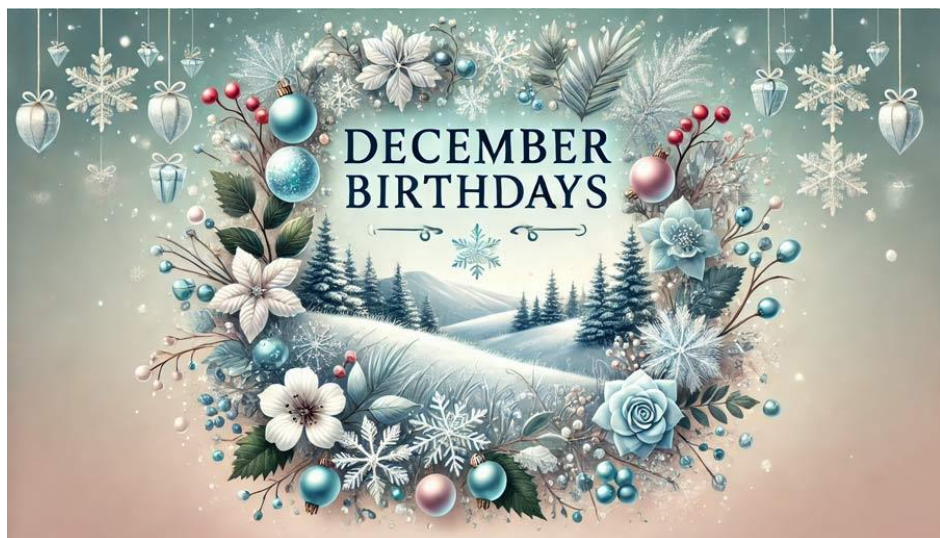
