Pastor's Ponderings.....

Holding Hope and Heartbreak

It can feel heavy to hold both hope and heartbreak at the same time. Scripture is full of such moments: manna in the wilderness that appears alongside hunger, liberation that leads not to arrival but to wandering, resurrection that follows loss rather than bypassing it. The Christian story—from the wilderness to the cross and beyond—suggests that faith is often formed precisely in that tension of hope and heartbreak, not on one side of it or the other.

In recent weeks, we have already begun a number of conversations together. Through the Thriving Church discussions, the Mission Cafés, our work around place-based ministry, and the sharing of congregational survey responses, we have been paying attention—to our life together, to the patterns that have shaped us, and to the questions emerging about our future. This work has not been about fixing or finalizing. It has been about noticing what is present and learning how to speak honestly about it.

At the same time, we are not having these conversations apart from the world we inhabit. Many of us are carrying grief, anger, and deep concern in response to the murders of civilians by federal immigration agents in Minneapolis which have sparked widespread outrage and demands for accountability. These realities press in on us much like they do throughout Scripture—not as interruptions to faithful living, but as part of the context in which faith takes shape.

Throughout the biblical story, discernment rarely happens in moments of calm or certainty. More often, God's people find themselves asking hard questions while unsettled—wandering in the wilderness, lamenting in exile, struggling to recognize new life even when it stands among them. In that light, it may feel uncomfortable to speak about thriving at a moment when so much remains unresolved. But thriving, as we are exploring it, is not about ease or momentum. It is about learning how to remain rooted, responsive, and faithful when clarity is limited.

Each of the different conversations we are having is helping us attend more carefully to who we are becoming and how we are called to live in this particular place and time. They ask us to slow down, to remain in relationship, and to resist the pull toward premature clarity. This work is rarely dramatic. It is steady, demanding, and often unfinished—much like the faith we inherit from Scripture itself.

As we continue together, my hope is not that we resolve the tension between hope and heartbreak, but that we learn how to hold it with care. Faith is not formed by avoiding what is difficult, but by remaining present to it—trusting that God is at work not only in what is new and energizing, but also in what remains unsettled.

5 A donation is customary for dedication and may be placed in an envelope in the collection basket.
